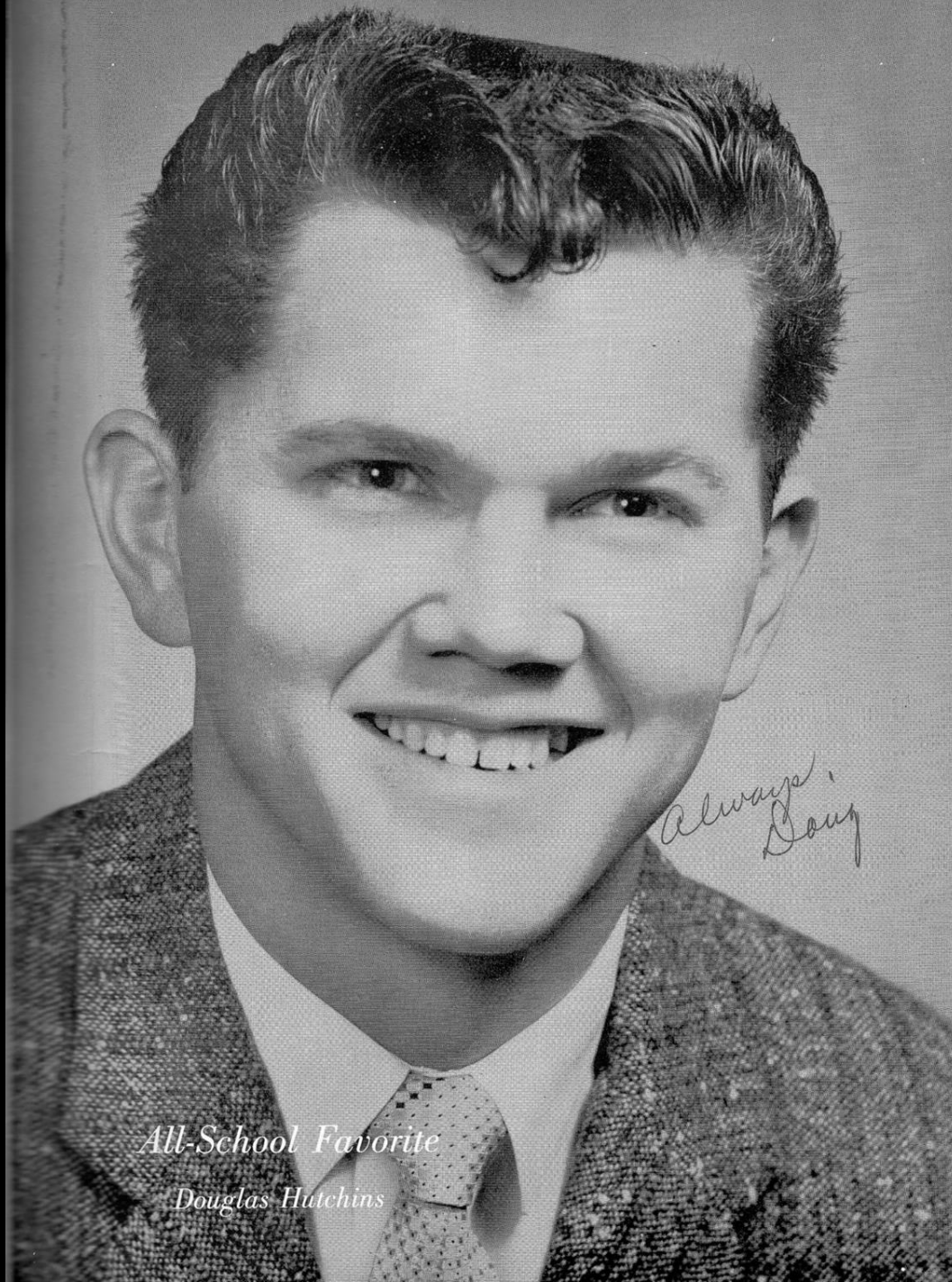

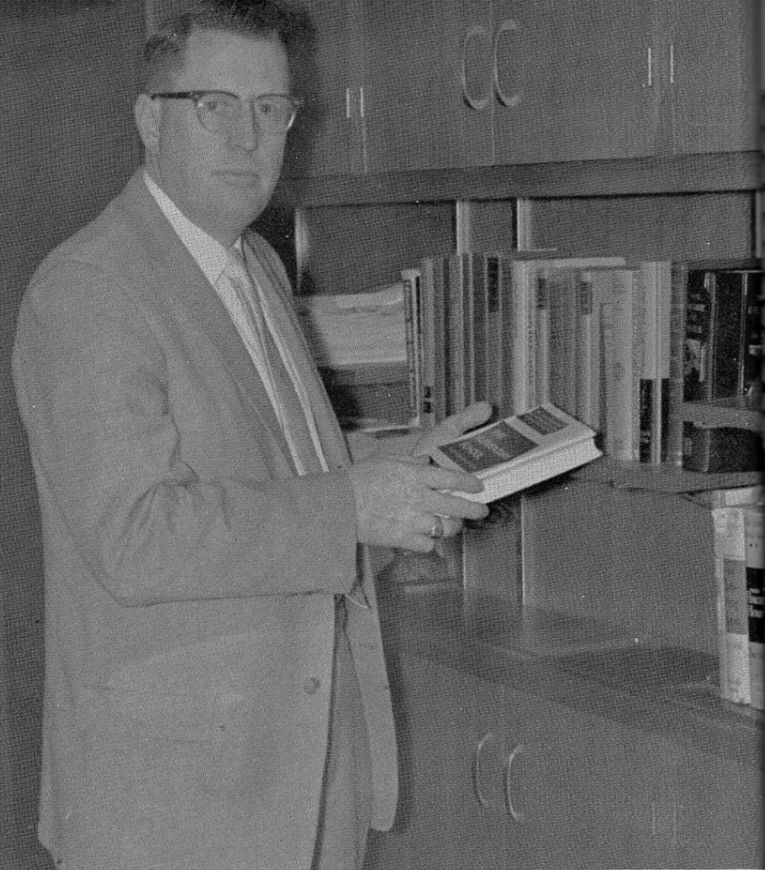

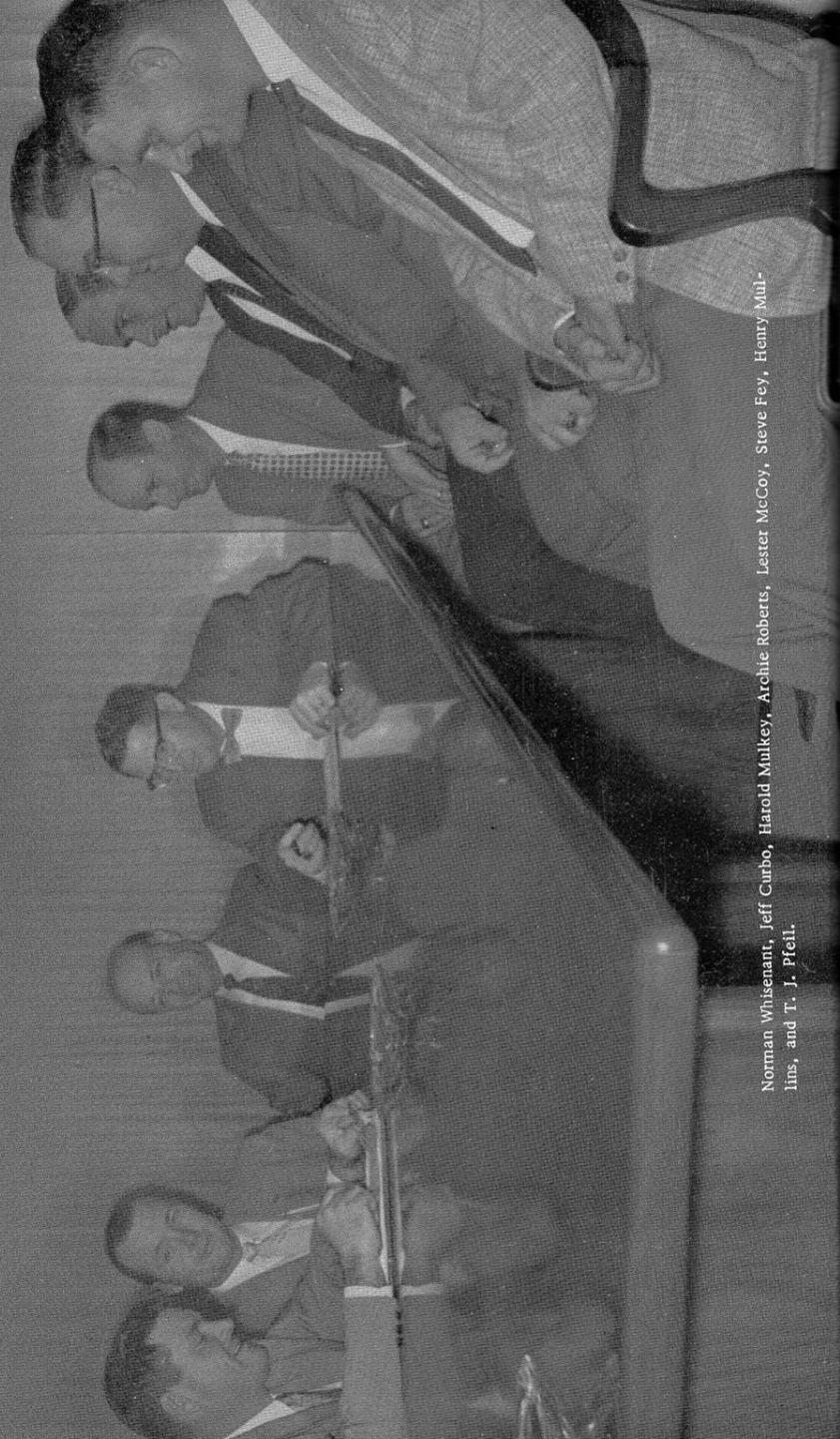
Principal's Message
