Principal's Message

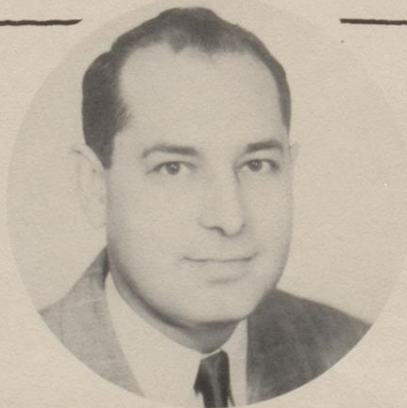
