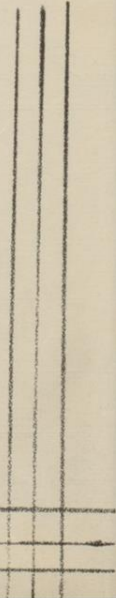
For all of us this is another year; for some of us it will be a really new and different year; while for others this school year will mean novel achievement, original adventure and fresh, vigorous service to the school and community.
